The Matthews Scholarship honors Mildred Gregory Byars Matthews, wife of George T. Matthews. Mildred Matthews was an art historian specializing in American Art who taught at Oakland University in the early years of the department. The scholarship is funded by an endowment established by George T. Matthews, a charter member of the Oakland University faculty, former Chair of the Department of History and Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences.

ELIGIBILITY:

- The applicant be a declared art history major in good standing,
- have completed at least 20 credit hours in art history prior to the application,
- have a minimum GPA of 3.3 in art history,
- have participated in an extracurricular art or art history activity
- have been enrolled as a student at Oakland University for both fall and winter semesters.

SIZE OF AWARD: \$500. The funds will be applied toward the recipient's tuition during the next semester enrolled.
